


Year 5 Spring 2 2023 Learning Challenge

<p style="text-align: center;">Successful Learners</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Areas of Learning</p> <p>As Mathematicians we will compare and order fractions greater than 1. We will add three or more fractions. We will add and subtract mixed numbers. We will multiply a 2-digit number by a 3-digit number and solve problems with multiplication.</p> <p>As Geographers we will use the 4 figure grid references in order to communicate knowledge of the United Kingdom. We will identify and describe how the physical features affect the human activity within a location. We will collect and analyse statistics in order to draw conclusions about a location. We will describe how geographical regions are interdependent and interconnected.</p> <p>In R.E We will retell the Easter Story in detail and talk with understanding about the Christian belief that Jesus died and rose victoriously and what that means to Christians. We will explain why Christians believe Jesus' death and resurrection is a victory. We will make links between people's values and commitments and their attitudes and behaviour with regards situations of victory.</p> <p>As Artists we will create a collage that incorporates text. We will use a sketch book and explain how an idea has developed over time. We will study author's skills and techniques and use this information to improve our own writing. We will focus on authorial intent and vocabulary choices as well as looking at how to create atmosphere through setting descriptions.</p> <p>As Readers we will continue to read and discuss an increasingly wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction and reference or text books and read books that are structured in different ways and read for a range of purposes. We will recommend books that we have read to our peers, giving reasons for our choices</p> <p>As scientists we will describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system. We will describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth. We will describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as appropriately spherical bodies. We will use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.</p> <p>As musicians we will maintain our own part in a performance with confidence, accuracy and an awareness of what others are playing.</p>

<p>We will be focusing on building Collaboration and understanding the importance of skills like turn-taking, sharing responsibility and listening to each other. We will relate these skills to all the learning we are doing and learn the importance of being able to assess our own progress in these Building Learning Powers.</p>
