### Successful Learners Areas of Learning

As geographers we will be doing an indepth study of Spain. We will locate it on maps and look at its human and physical features. We will compare and contrast how the country has capitalised on its human and physical features.

<u>As scientists</u> we will continue to look at material properties and changes. We will carry out investigations to observe changes of state when materials are heated or cooled

As mathematicians we will be doing lots of number work, which will involve focusing on our times tables and applying the skills we have learnt this year to solve problems. We will practice solving more one and two step word problems linked to length and perimeter.

### Successful Learners Areas of Learning

As readers and writers, we will be creating persuasive articles based on bull fighting. We will also continue reading our class novel 'Oliver and the Seawigs'.

<u>As artists</u> we will study the work of the Spanish artist, Miro. We will draw from close observation to capture the fine details. We will comment on an artist, explaining the approaches taken.

As design technologists we will be studying Spanish foods, Tapas. We will measure and weigh ingredients appropriately to prepare and cook a range of savoury dishes.

<u>In computing</u> we will use the internet to research information. We will also be using the computer to write for different audiences and link this to our learning challenge work.

In <u>Religious Education</u> we will be looking at prayer throughout the faiths and also the symbolism of Easter as a story focusing on betrayal and trust.
