Areas of Learning

As Geographers we will be looking at world maps, atlases and globes to locate the UK. We will use aerial images to recognise famous landmarks and physical features of each country. We will use geographical vocabulary to describe different places and then draw our own maps.

As scientists we will be looking at our bodies and how they are the same but very different. We will be learning about our different senses and what their jobs are.
