

Annual Reviews

Some children will have an Education Health Care Plan, which is a legal document written by the Local Authority to support the child, parents and school with targets and provision to help them make progress.

Every year these are reviewed in school by parents, staff and other agencies that may be working with the child. We involve the child in the review, sharing information about what is going well, what might be proving difficult, and what we would like to do next.

In Year Five we hold a Transition Review so that High School placements, needs and difficulties can be discussed. An Inclusion Officer from Tameside will attend the Transition Review.
